## In fall 2022, 97% of First-Time in College<sup>1</sup> and 90% of Undergraduate<sup>2</sup> students were awarded scholarship<sup>3</sup>, grant, and/or loan aid.

- 1. First-Time in College constitutes the GRS (Graduation Rate Survey) cohort which is used to calculate the six-year graduation rate. First-Time in College students includes those who earned pre-college credit and entered at the sophomore classification.
- 2. Undergraduates, which includes First-Time in College, constitutes first bachelor degree-seeking students (freshman, sophomore, junior, senior). Post-baccalaureate students were excluded.
- 3. Scholarships include both merit and need-based scholarships.
- 4. Fall 2022 direct costs include published tuition amount of \$6,162, the minimum on-campus housing rate and meal plan of \$5,595, an estimate of \$600 for books (source: Student Financial Aid Office).
- 5. Calculated by the Office of Financial Aid.
- 6. Data provided are based upon financial aid award offers and not actual disbursements. Offered award amounts that are estimated may differ from disbursed amounts. Financial aid earned in bi-weekly paychecks by students working in the Federal Work-Study program were excluded from this analysis.
