- 2. Undergraduates, which includes First-Time in College, constitutes first bachelor degree-seeking students (freshman, sophomore, junior, senior). Post-baccalaureate students were excluded.
- 3. Scholarships include both merit and need-based scholarships.
- 4. Fall 2020 direct costs include published tuition amount of \$5,983, the minimum on-campus housing rate and meal plan of \$4,782, an estimate of \$600 for books (source: Student Financial Aid Office).
